CONTROLLING STUBBLE BURNING

Free of cost spraying of PUSA bio-decomposer
in more than 4000 acres of farmlands in Delhi

Anti-dust campaign

Online monitoring of all construction and demolition sites and increased frequency of mechanized road sweeping

Preventing pollution by burning

Day and night patrolling across all areas in Delhi to strictly monitor garbage and biomass burning in colonies

Banning firecrackers

Ban on use along with sale and purchase of firecrackers till the end of December 2021 to prevent pollution

Set-up of Smog Tower

Country's first smog tower has recently been started in Connaught Place to purify the air in nearby areas

Identifying & monitoring hotspots

Identification of hotspots based on complaints received on Green Delhi app and strict monitoring by special teams

Strengthening of Green War Room

50 new environmental engineers, launch of Green Fellowship, and support from EPIC-India and GDI Partners

Green Delhi App

New Green Delhi mobile app for citizens to report violations

Eco waste park

Set-up of India's first eco waste park over an area of 20 acres to prevent any pollution due to e-waste

Controlling vehicular pollution

Strict enforcement of Pollution Under Control (PUC) certificate and ban on old vehicles, 64 traffic choke points identified for streamlining
