

Primary Farsang 2022

18th February (Last Friday before Half Term)

Farsang is a festive period between Vízkereszt (Epiphany) and Hamvazószerda (Ash Wednesday).

Farsang is the time of fun and feast, traditionally aimed at chasing winter away and invite spring with laughter and joy. Hungarians eat a lot of doughnuts and have fancy dress parties in this season.

On the day of Farsang, Primary **students can dress up** as anything they want to. Traditionally *Farsang* is about

- 10. Teachers' Prize (for the teacher with the best costume)
- 11. House Captains' Choice (voted by House Captains)

On 18th February, students can arrive in their costumes in the morning. For those who do not want to dress up, it will be a non-uniform day. In the afternoon there will be fun activities in key stages at 4 different stations.
