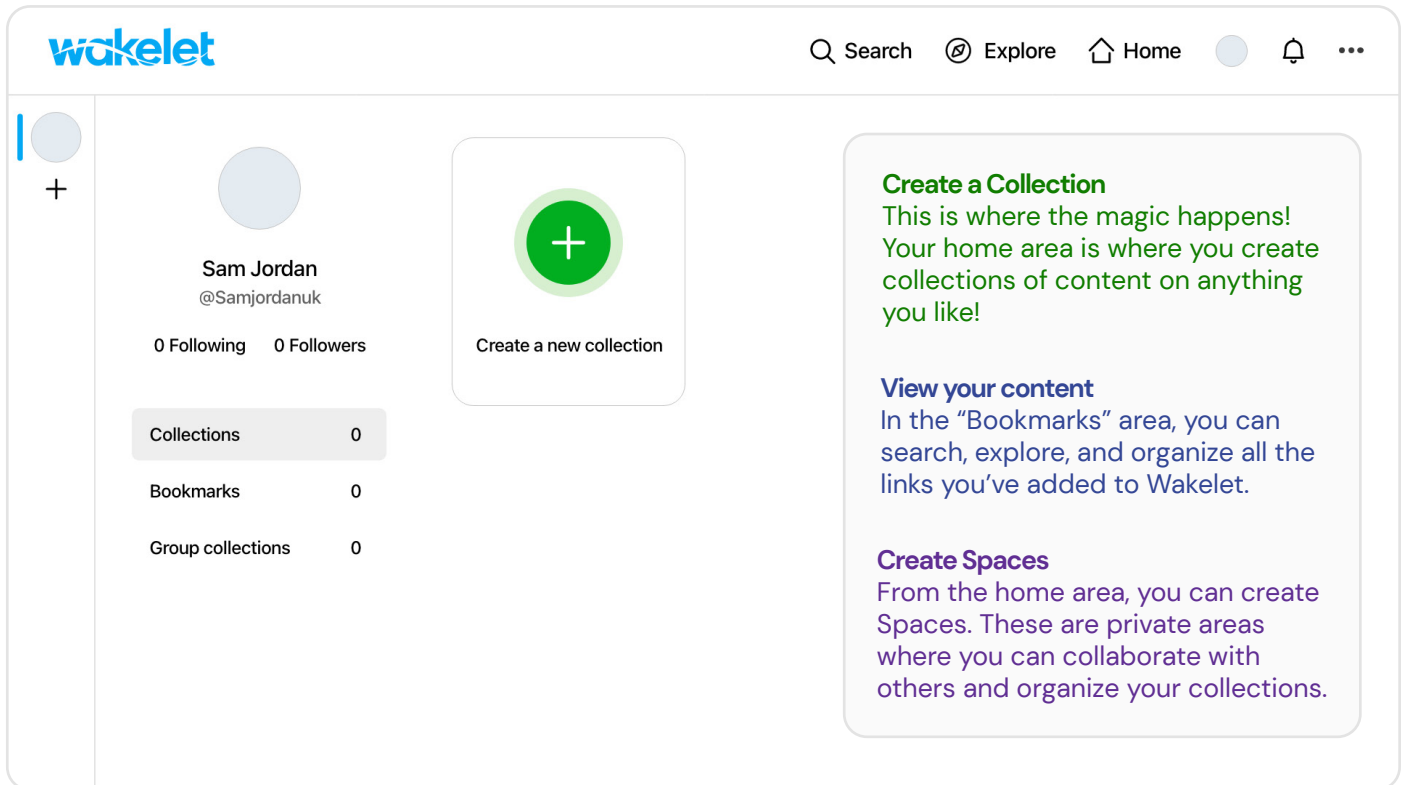

Creating your first collection

Starting off your collection

Collections are at the heart of the Wakelet platform.

Collections are groups of content from the web, arranged and organized however you want. Add your own personal content and create collections on any topic!



Create a new collection

Click the plus button!

Simply click the big green plus button to create a collection. You can create as many as you like, and update them whenever you wish.

Title & Description

Add a title and description to let people know what your collection is about!



Cover Image

Add a cover image to make your collection look sharp! You can either upload an image from your computer, or add one from our free image library.



Layout

Choose from 4 different layouts to make your content even more engaging. You can choose from list view, grid view, media view, and mood board!

Adding Items to your collections

Add your first item

It's time to add your first item! Try copying and pasting a link from the web. A Youtube video, article, podcast or website is usually a good start!



Paste any link

You can paste any link that you want from the web and it will appear in your collection. Mixed media like video will usually embed in the collection too!



Add text

Adding text brings context and depth to your collections. You can add instructions, descriptions, or anything else!



Upload photo's

You can upload photos and pictures from your computer, or choose from our HD image library!



Add Bookmarks

You can also add any of your saved bookmarks to your collection by clicking the bookmark icon in the middle!



Upload PDF's

Upload PDF's by pressing the PDF button and selecting the document from your devices storage.



Add from other services

You can choose from our list of integrations to add content from other platforms!

Record a Video!

Use the video button to record a Flipgrid video directly in the collection.

You can screen record and upload videos too!



Top Tip! Copy Collection

In edit collection mode, hit the gear icon in the top left and toggle the "copy collection" button. This will allow people to copy your collection – perfect for templates and assignments!

Visibility options

There are 3 different options for visibility

Public

Everyone is able to see your collection and it will appear on your public profile (Page 6)



Unlisted

Only people you share your collection with will be able to see it.



Private

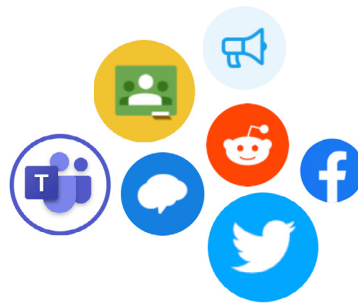
Only you can see your collection.



Sharing your Collection

You can share your Wakelet collection in a number of different ways!

Start by pressing the "share" button!



Integrations

We're integrated with your favorite platforms, where you can share collections to directly!

Copy the link

An easy way to share your collection is via the shortened URL via the share button.



QR Code

Make a QR Code which will take people directly to your collection! It's great for presentations and scavenger hunts!

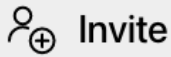

Inviting Contributors

Invite people to collaborate on your collection – in real time!

There are a few different ways you can invite people to add their own items to your collection.

Start by pressing the
“invite” button!



Copy the link

The quickest way to invite contributors is to share the “join link”. When they click this link, they will be taken to the collection.

Even if they are not logged into Wakelet they can still contribute to this collection.



Via the QR Code

Perfect for presenting, you can share the QR code on a screen, and people can scan it to join the collection!



Via user name or Email

If you want to send out an individual invitation, you can send it through Wakelet user name or email.



Via the Collab Code

You can also use a unique code. People can go to www.wakelet.com, and click “enter code” to collaborate if they don’t have an account. Or they can do it from within their home area!

Permissions Top Tip!

Manage contributors via the **invite** button. **By default, no contributor can delete or change the collection, or other people’s contributions.**



What is a Space?

A space is a separate area in your account where you can invite people to collaborate and create their own collections! It’s perfect for teams, groups and classrooms!

To create a Space

Just click the plus button on the side panel of your home area.



Publish your Space

In Space Settings you can publish your space, making it appear as a public profile!



Collaborate in your Space

Click the members panel to invite people to collaborate, create their own collections and contribute to others. It’s a great way for a group of people to work on the same thing at once!

Joining a collection

Ways you can join a collaborative collection

Collaboration Code

Got a collaboration code? In your home area, just click group collections and then click the join collection button to enter your code.



Join Collection

Collaboration link

Got a link? simply click it to jump right in.



QR code

Simply open the camera on your mobile or laptop and point it towards the code to scan. You will be taken to the collection – just like magic!



Email / user name

If you've been invited to a collection, you'll receive an email. Follow the link in the email to join the collection and add your own content.



No Wakelet Account?

No problem! Just head to www.wakelet.com and click the enter code button. Use a collaboration code to join!

Space Code

If you have a code, just click the plus button on the left hand panel of your home area. Click the Join a space button to enter the code and join the Space.

If you've been invited to a Space, you'll receive an email. Follow the link in the email to join the space and add your own content.

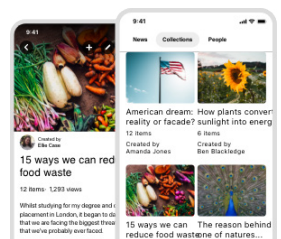
